

GLEN PARK JOINT BOARD MEETING

FOR MAY 8, 2024
GLEN PARK PAVILION

IN ATTENDANCE: Amy Jackson, Paul Krieter, Bob Krieter, Doug Richardson, Christina Bleckinger, Eileen Torre, Peter Warn, and Annette Herrman.

CALL TO ORDER: The Glen Park Joint Board members toured the park at 7PM prior to the meeting to make plans for the upcoming "Love Your Park Clean-Up Day" scheduled for Saturday, May 11, 2024. We anticipate a group of eighteen Girl Scouts, plus volunteers from the community to help us as we pick up trash, weed, and spread mulch in the gardens. Chairperson Amy Jackson called the meeting to order at 7:26PM.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: Minutes of the April 10, 2024 meeting of the Glen Park Joint Board were accepted and posted on the Village and Town websites.

BUDGET MONITORS REVIEW: Glen Park Joint Board Fund balance is (\$10,685.88). Anticipated funding from the Village and the Town in 2024 will remedy.

LIAISON'S INPUTS:

- TOWN: ANGELA MARINUCCI - no report submitted
- VILLAGE: EILEEN TORRE The "Small pond" will be dredged by the Village DPW beginning W/O 5/13. The "large pond" should also be dredged (both should be done every five years), but this is beyond the scope of the Village DPW. Therefore, Trustee Torre has sent a request to Mr. Floss, Town of Amherst Highway Department Superintendent, asking for the Town's assistance.

Trustee Torre recommended a free app called "PlantNet" which helps identify weeds in your garden.

ITEMS DISCUSSED:

- Updates on review of Village and Town's websites to correct Glen Park info: Annette Herrman Volunteered to research the archives and compile the list of missing documents. If possible, all will be retrieved, either digitally, from the Village, or using hard copies from Board Members.
- Update on review Glen Park Guidance Document: P.J. Glauber and Paul Krieter are digitizing and will report next month.

- Update on Beautification Committee involvement in Glen Park: Beautification Committee offers its services in an advisory capacity only.
- Overview of LOVE OUR PARK DAY 5/11/24 – See above.
- Update on the exterior water service: A shut-off valve has been added inside the bathroom to control the north side outer faucet. A faucet will be installed on the south side of the Pavilion to enable a hose to be connected to serve the two gardens between the Pavilion and Glen Ave. This is a change from the original plan, which was to install an underground water line to service the two gardens between the Pavilion and Glen Ave.

Also, the ADA GUIDELINES (Americans with Disabilities Act) set clear standards for commercial bathroom mirrors to support access for disabled users, mainly those in wheelchairs:

- o Full-length mirrors: At least one unbreakable, full-length mirror must be installed in the bathroom. This mirror should measure at least 60 inches long and 36 inches wide, with the bottom edge no higher than 40 inches from the ground and the top edge no higher than 80 inches.

Trustee Torre to email Ben at Village DPW regarding these matters.
